Our target for attendance is 97%, so very well done Year 2 for achieving the target last term. Both Year 4 and Year 5 were extremely close, with Years 1, 3 and 6 noticeably lower.

Please continue to make attendance an absolute priority for the rest of this term. Children need to be in school all the time so that they don't miss any vital learning and to make sure that they keep up with their peers.

239 children had attendance of over 97% for term 1, which is a fantastic achievement. Let's aim for even more children achieving 97% or more attendance this term.

## Some reminders which will really help with the smooth running of the school day

**1. Starts and Ends of the School Day:** Please be on time in the morning and at the end of the school day. We have noticed that a number of parents/carers are late picking their children up. This can make it very difficult for staff who have meetings or training to go to and there are still children waiting to be collected.

**2. Only healthy snacks please:** We only allow children to have fruit or vegetable snacks during morning play. If a child is on the playground with items such as a chocolate bar or packet of crisps, we will ask them to go inside and put it back in their bag.

**3. Every child must have a PE kit:** Please make sure that your child has a PE kit in school, ready to be worn at all times. This is an essential part of being ready for school, and too many children have to borrow PE kit as they do not have a full set in school for themselves.

**4. Only use the school car park if you have a permit:** Parents and carers must have a permit to drive onto the school site at the start or end of the school day. (The only exception being Butler Club parents who drop off before 7.45 am and pick up after 5.15 pm, much earlier/later than most families.) If you do not have a permit, please use the Wantage Memorial Park car park and make the short walk to school.

We held a fantastic Open Morning on Tuesday this week. We had six tour groups whom we had the pleasure of showing around Wantage CE Primary School. The school was looking excellent, and the visitors on each tour com-



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mented on everyone's immaculate behaviour and friendly welcome in every class.
